

## 6.2 Bonithon Ave Reserve

### Description

Location:	Bonithon Avenue
Legal description:	Lot 24 DP 5000
Size:	0.27 ha
Reserve status:	Reserve



### Physical description

This reserve, situated within the residential area of Moturoa is flat to gently sloping. Mature bush is located both within and surrounding the northern boundary

### Tangata whenua interests

This reserve is within the tribal rohe of Te Atiawa Iwi. The area is of historic and cultural significance to Ngati Te Whiti.

### Land status and history

The property was transferred to the Mayor, Councillors and Burgesses of New Plymouth in 1929 for the purpose of recreation reserve upon subdivision. In 1983 the land was classified as a Local Purpose (site for scout hall) reserve by way of gazette notice.

### Existing improvements

A scout hall is located within the reserve which is owned by New Zealand Scouting, who has a lease for the land that the building occupies.

**Uses and activities**

The reserve is predominantly used for scout meetings. The reserve also acts as an entrance to the Westown School playing fields.

**Classification**

Local purpose (site for scout hall) reserve

**Management objectives and specific policies**

- This reserve will continue to be managed and developed as a site suitable for community facilities and open space for use by local residents.
