Description

Location: Upper Carrington Street

Legal description: Lots 17 DP 6992 and Lot 27 DP 7932

Size: 0.45 ha
Reserve status: Reserve

Physical description

These two parcels are located on the road frontage of Carrington Street at a point just before Carrington Street becomes Carrington Road. The reserve is a predominately flat, open, grassed area with a few specimen trees around the outer edge.

Tangata whenua interests

This reserve is within the tribal rohe of Te Atiawa Iwi. The area is of historic and cultural significance to Ngati Te Whiti.

Land status and history

Lot 27 DP 7932 and Lot 17 DP 6992 were vested in Her Majesty the Queen for recreation purposes in 1957 and 1962 respectively subject to the reserves and Domain Act 1953. The Crown vested the land in trust in the Taranaki County Council for recreation purposes in 1962 and 1969 respectively. The underlying titles remain with the crown.

Existing improvements

Post and rail barriers on the road frontage of this reserve are the only existing improvements.


This area is suitable for picnics and large enough for casual recreational activities.
