General conditions

- a) On receipt of a requirement from the Chief Executive, Taranaki Regional Council the consent holder shall, within the time specified in the requirement, supply the information required relating to the exercise of this consent.
- b) Unless it is otherwise specified in the conditions of this consent, compliance with any monitoring requirement imposed by this consent must be at the consent holder's own expense.
- c) The consent holder shall pay to the Council all required administrative charges fixed by the Council pursuant to section 36 in relation to:
 - i) the administration, monitoring and supervision of this consent; and
 - ii) charges authorised by regulations.

Special conditions

- 1. The discharge shall not exceed 6.26 cubic metres/day.
- 2. The centre of the discharge area shall be located at 1682240E-5668290N.
- ③ No contaminants shall be discharged within 150 metres of any dwelling, nor within 50 metres from any bore, well or spring used for water supply purposes, nor within 25 metres of any surface water body.
- 4. The discharge shall not result in any discharge of contaminants to surface water.
- 5. The discharge shall not result in ponding on the surface that remains for more than three hours after the discharge has ceased.
- ⑥ The area of application shall be at least 2.76 hectares.
- ⑦ The return period between applications of effluent shall be at least 20 days.
- 8. The treatment/discharge system shall be operated and regularly maintained to ensure that the conditions of this consent are met.

The Taranaki Regional Council may review any or all of the conditions of this consent by giving notice of review during June 2013 and/or June 2019, for the purpose of ensuring that the conditions are adequate to deal with any significant adverse effects on the environment arising from the exercise of this consent, which either were not foreseen at the time the application was considered or which it was not appropriate to deal with at the time.
