I find it interesting that the applicant makes statements such as "fair opportunity" when there has been no fair qualities displayed after promises made during the Paddocks Hearing. This whole porcess has been unfair on the community and as lay people we have been disadvantaged from the start.

I also find the threat of "appeal risk" distasteful. This adds more unnecessary stress to submitters and their families.

I agree with many other submitters that the hearing should now be closed and the commissioners decision should be made on the evidence already provided.
