The land was vested in the New Plymouth District Council upon subdivision in 1989 as recreation reserve subject to the Reserves Act 1977.

Existing improvements

This reserve has amenity landscaping. A playground containing swings, slide and a seesaw exists on the reserve along with three park benches.

Uses and activities

This reserve is suitable for picnicking and child's play.
